Preamble

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Director General and Chief of Regulatory and Quarantine Division, Bhutan Agriculture & Food Regulatory Authority, MoAF.

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- a) To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the Bhutan Agriculture & Food Regulatory Authority consistent with the 12th Five Year Plan of the Ministry, and Government's other priorities;
- b) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the overall performance of the Bhutan Agriculture & Food Regulatory Authority at the end of the financial year

The Performance Agreement represents an important accountability mechanism for inculcating a performance based culture at all levels of government.
