## POST-MORTEM INSPECTION REPORT

#### A. General Instruction for post-mortem inspection

- Routine postmortem examination of a carcass should be carried out as soon as possible after the completion of dressing in order to detect any abnormalities so that products only conditionally fit for human consumption are not passed as food.
- All organs and carcass portions should be kept together and correlated for inspection before they are removed from the slaughter floor
- The inspector should ensure that the premises, equipment and facilities required to conduct examination is conducive and available.
- In order to prevent the contamination of carcass, heads and viscera, it is essential that the basic requirements of hygiene are strictly enforced.
- All carcass or parts thereof shall be properly dressed and cleaned prior to inspection or evisceration. All hair, scurf and dirt shall be removed from the hog carcass.
- Carcass should be separated from each other to avoid contact and contamination once the removal of hide, skin or pelt has commenced. Separation of carcass, heads and viscera should be maintained until they have been examined and passed by the inspector.



#### C. Post-mortem Examination

*Post-mortem inspection* should be carried out in adequate lighting where the carcasses can be observed both collectively and individually. Examine carcasses (including musculature, exposed bones, joints, tendon sheaths etc.) to determine any signs of disease or defect. Attention should be paid to bodily condition, efficiency of bleeding, colour, condition of serous membranes (pleura and peritoneum), cleanliness and presence of any unusual odours.






